

Business Continuity Plan Disclosure Statement

Eden Global Partners LLC, Eden Global Capital Partners LLC and Eden Global Advisor LLC (collectively, “Eden”) has developed a Business Continuity Plan on how we will respond to events that significantly disrupt our business. Since the timing and impact of disasters and disruptions is unpredictable, we will be flexible in responding to actual events as they occur. With that in mind, we are providing you with this information on our business continuity plan.

Our Business Continuity Plan: We plan to quickly recover and resume business operations after a significant business disruption and respond by safeguarding our employees and property, making a financial and operational assessment, protecting the firm’s books and records, and allowing our customers to transact business. In short, our business continuity plan is designed to permit our firm to resume operations as quickly as possible, given the scope and severity of the significant business disruption.

Our business continuity plan addresses: data backup and recovery; mission critical systems; financial and operational assessments; alternative communications with customers, employees, regulators; alternate physical location of employees; counter-party impact; regulatory reporting; and assuring our customers prompt access to their funds and securities if we are unable to continue our business in the rare event that we are holding customer funds or securities. Our IT service providers, , together with data storage and archiving vendors, back up our electronic records regularly.

Varying Disruptions: Significant business disruptions can vary in their scope, such as only our firm, a single building housing our firm, the business district where our firm is located, the city where we are located, or the whole region. Within each of these areas, the severity of the disruption can vary from minimal to severe.

In a disruption to only our firm or a building housing our firm, we will transfer our operations to a local site if needed and will continue our operations, with our employees working remotely. We expect to recover and resume business promptly. In a disruption affecting our business district, city, or region, we will transfer our operations to a site outside of the affected area with employees working remotely and recover and resume business as quickly as possible.

In either situation, we plan to continue conducting business and to notify customers using the communications means closest in speed and form (written or oral) to what has been used in the past. If the significant business disruption is so severe that it prevents us from remaining in business, we will immediately notify our customers to the best of our ability.
